We place flags on Veterans headstones on Memorial Day and Veterans Day each year.



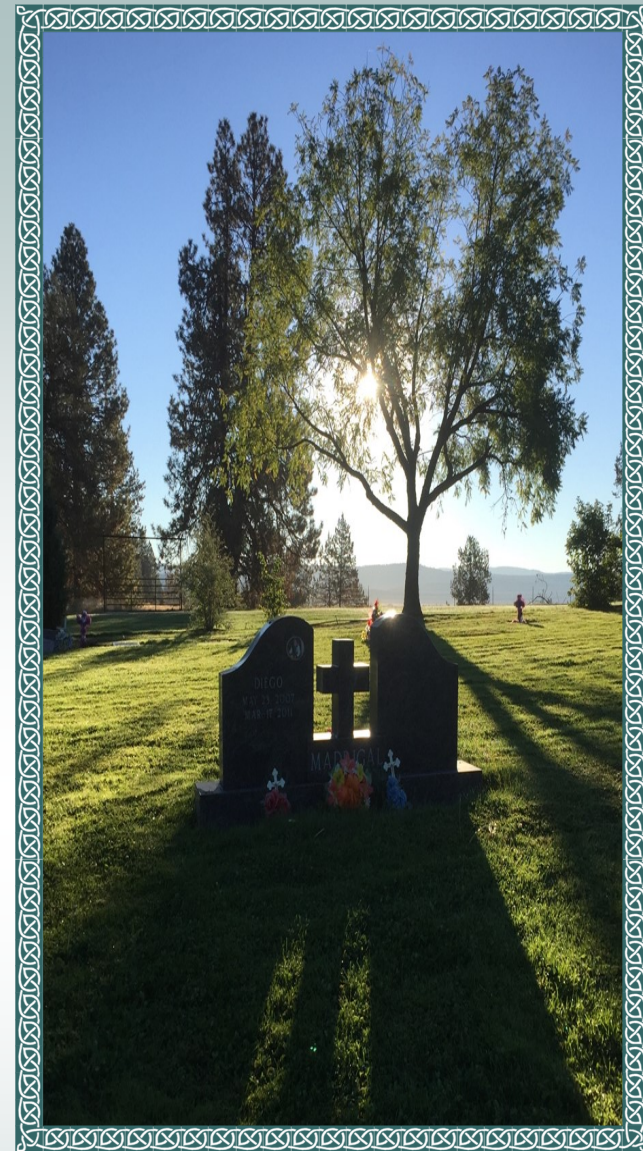
PEACEFUL AND CLEAN

Please help us to maintain a serene atmosphere by observing the following requests:

- *Real or artificial flowers allowed at gravesites. Flowers will be discarded as needed. No glass or breakable containers are allowed except during services.*
- *The district allows both upright and flat permanent memorial markers except for the new area on east side of Pine Grove Cemetery where only flat markers are allowed. Only Granite, Bronze or Marble markers allowed.*
- *No plantings allowed at gravesites, but donations for trees and shrubs in memory are gratefully accepted. Plaques will accompany the memorial tree or shrub.*
- *Please pick up after yourself and throw away any trash you bring in with you.*
- *No alcoholic beverages are allowed on cemetery grounds.*

OUR SERVICES

Paying tribute to a life is a personal decision that may be based on your religious beliefs, cultural heritage, family tradition, financial considerations and personal preferences. In order to accommodate your wishes, we offer a full range of services to commemorate your loved one's life.

Full Ground Burial, or interment, is the most traditional form of burial. Cremation, followed by burial of the cremains within a plot is another common practice. We also offer a Scatter Garden where cremains are gently raked into the soil within our Scatter garden.

WHAT IS A SCATTER GARDEN

Scattering one's remains in a cemetery is becoming more and more desired for families to have a location to visit their loved ones. Here at Pine Grove, we offer a place where you can visit your loved one, while still honoring their final wishes of being scattered. We have dedicated a special area with a beautiful view of the valley and Pit River, selectively planted with shrubs and perennials where cremains may be gently raked into the soil. Individuals will be provided a plaque on a remembrance wall located within the garden.

OUR BOARD

Trustees of the district consist of five community members appointed and approved by the Shasta County Board of Supervisors. Regular board meetings are held on the second Wednesday of the month. For more information or dates please contact the office.

Includes open/close, liner, temporary marker, table and chairs \$ 1100.00 + plot = \$ 1400.00

Cremation

Includes open/close, permanent vault, temporary marker, table, and chairs

\$ 300.00 + plot = \$ 450.00-\$ 600.00

Scatter Garden

Includes table and chairs, plaque for remembrance wall \$ 350.00

on Ted Elder Rd.
(Cremations)*

*Winters Cemetery located within the Fall
River Golf Club
(Historic—no new burials permitted)*

NOTICE

The manager requires four days notice in order to prepare for an interment. All fees must be paid in full prior to service. No interments will be scheduled on Sundays or holidays. All markers must be approved by management.

HISTORY

The Pine Grove Cemetery District was formed by order of the Shasta County Board of Supervisors on July 8, 1925. The land for the cemetery was donated by the McArthur Family. We also take care of the Dana Cemetery. In 2017 Pine Grove Cemetery merged with the Fall River Cemetery District adding Fall River Cemetery and Winters Cemetery.
